How do horses get EEE? Horses become infected when they are bitten by a mosquito carrying the EEE virus What time of the year does EEE infect horses? EEE cases in horses usually begin to appear in mid to late summer and increase into the fall In 1998, following a warm winter, infected horses were seen in south Louisiana beginning in early spring

Is cloning horses ethical?

- Prevent horses that have come in contact with known infected or clinical cases from mixing with the general population
- Contaminated stall and equipment should have all organic material removed Dispose of organic matter in a manner which prevents contamination of the facility (do not spread on pastures) Disinfection
